Fractal Sample Scarf

The following were used for the sample scarf, but any size yarn will work. Just use a gauge that is open enough to allow a good drape.

Gauge: 6 stitches per inch

Yarn: 4 oz DK weight (about 350 yards)

Needles: Size 7

Width: 6 ½ " Length 68"

PATTERN:

Cast on 43 stitches (or multiple of 7 + 8)

Beginning Border:

Row 1: Knit

Row 2-5: Slip 1, Knit

Pattern Rows:

Row 6 (right side—front-- of scarf): Slip1, K3, (K2tog, YO, K5) repeat to last 4 stitches

Row 7 and all odd rows (back of scarf): Slip 1, Purl

Row 8: Slip1, K3, K1 (K2tog, YO, K5) repeat to last 4 stitches, K4

Row 10: Slip1, K3, K2 (K2tog, YO, K5) repeat to last 4 stitches, K4 (last repeat will end with K4)

Row 12: Slip1, K3, K3 (K2tog, YO, K5) repeat to last 4 stitches, K4 (last repeat will end with K3)

Row 14: Slip1, K3, K4 (K2tog, YO, K5) repeat to last 4 stitches, K4 (last repeat will end with K2)

Row 16: Slip1, K3, K5 (K2tog, YO, K5) repeat to last 4 stitches, K4 (last repeat will end with K1)

Row 18: Slip1, K3, K6 (K2tog, YO, K5) repeat to last 4 stitches, K4 (last repeat will end with YO)

Repeat Rows 6-19 until desired length.

Ending Border:

Knit 5 Rows, beginning each with a slip stitch.

Bind Off on 5th row.

Weave in ends. Blocking will remove curling.
